Day 1 :- Feb 23 Departure from US to Egypt on overnight flight

Day 2 :- Feb 24 (Arrival)

Arrival at Cairo International Airport after your overnight flight from the US. Advantage International staff will escort you from the US. Then assisted through immigration and customs then met by our Egyptian representative , transfer to the 5 Star Cairo Conrad Hotel & over night.



Day 3 :- Feb 25 (Cairo)

After breakfast, enjoy a full-day trip starting with the Step Pyramid of Saqqara; a milestone in the evolution of monumental stone architecture - Continue to visit Memphis then visit the three most spectacular pyramids of Egypt; the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx & enjoy a short Camel ride at the Giza Plateau. Lunch will be included during the tour. Egyptian Cuisine.



Day 4 :- Feb 26 (Cairo)

Breakfast at the hotel , day tour visit the Egyptian Museum , continue our day tour to visit the Islamic quarters of Cairo, including the Citadel of Saladin, the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali Pasha - Stroll along Al-Mu'izz Street, an open air museum for Islamic Monuments where a maze of Mosques, Sabils (water fountains), Kuttabs (Quranic schools), Houses and Wekalas (trade complex) truly reflect the splendour of Islamic architecture - End your tour at Khan-el-Khalili Bazaar , back to the hotel & over night . Late lunch will be included that day along with folkloric show performed at one of the Ancient Islamic houses or palaces. Please keep in mind that the show will be according to the availability and the schedule of performance.



Day 5 :- Feb 27 (Cairo / Luxor)

Breakfast at the hotel , transfer to Cairo airport , domestic flight to Luxor ,arrival , day tour visit the East Bank (Karnak & Luxor Temples) then transfer to the Deluxe 5 Star Sonesta Moon Goddess Ship , Embarkation before lunch , lunch & dinner at the cruise & over night.



Day 6 :- Feb 28 (Nile Cruise)

Breakfast at the cruise ,day tour visit the West Bank (Valley of the Kings , & Colossus of Memnon) , Lunch & Dinner at the cruise & over night on board.



Day 7 :- Feb 29 (Nile Cruise)

We will get to mingle with the family and their kids, along with the Nubian ladies and will have a short lecture about Nubians life then we will continue the tour to a Local Nubian School (Nursery). Back to the cruise for lunch. After lunch, enjoy a trip to the romantic Temple of Philae and the High Dam. Back to the cruise dinner & over night.

Day 9 :- March 2 (Aswan/Cairo)

Breakfast at the cruise , disembarkation , transfer to airport for flight to Cairo, or Optional tour to Abu Simbel* via domestic flight. The trip to Abu Simbel , includes transfer, arrival , visit the two temples of Ramsis II & his beautiful Wife Queen Nefertari, then domestic flight to Cairo. Arrival, transfer to your hotel & overnight.



Day 10 :- March 3 (Cairo Departure)

Breakfast at the hotel, checkout, transfer to Cairo Airport , to catch your early flight on to Dubai.

Dubai is one of the seven emirates and the most populous state of the United Arab Emirates (UAE). It is located along the southern coast of the Persian Gulf on the Arabian Peninsula. From the timeless tranquility of the desert, to the lively bustle of the souk, Dubai does not only boast the best contemporary sightings but has also preserved some of the most intriguing historical attractions.

Day 10: March 3 Arrive Dubai

Arrive at Dubai International Airport. After clearing immigration and custom formalities, you will be greeted by our representative and assisted with transfer to your hotel. Overnight stay at the Fairmont Hotel Dubai.

Day 11: March 4 Day in Dubai [B,D]

Enjoy your breakfast in the hotel. This morning is at your leisure for independent activities.



After your lunch proceed for the half-day city tour of Old & New Dubai. Dubai, the second largest Emirate, is the UAE's commercial center and is proudly referred to as the "City of Merchants". Dubai offers a fascinating kaleidoscope of contrasts – the old and new, the East and the West. Experience a variety of sights and scents of the Orient in a cosmopolitan setting - a true introduction to the Arabian Gulf.

The tour takes us to a variety of interesting attractions: we bring you close to the Burj Al Arab where you can take pictures of this world famous hotel. From there, we drive to the Jumeirah Mosque – a magnificent example of modern Islamic architecture. We drive past the ruler's palace and the Bastakia area – the oldest part of the city with its tall wind towers, which served as air-conditioners in bygone days.

The journey through the city center covers popular landmarks like the Museum, housed in the 18th century Al Fahidi Fort. The Museum features realistic displays, with sound effects, depicting various scenes, which provide a fascinating glimpse of the historical links of the city with trading and pearl diving. Enroute we pass by the ancient beautifully restored house of Sheikh Saeed Al Maktoum, built in a commanding position near the mouth of the Creek at Shindagha.

Proceed for Dhow Cruise with Dinner. *This evening enjoy a cruise by a traditional wooden dhow. Offering an intriguingly different view of the beautiful city, the cruise offers a delightful mix and match of traditional and modern way of life. Enjoy dinner on board the cruise with traditional dance & music performances.* Overnight stay at Hotel.
